1. General information

The Development Seminar targets all tournament coaches, trainers and, more generally, people involved in tournament skiing wishing to improve their knowledge. Cable ski coaches and trainers are welcome as there is a good crossover of skills and techniques. This Seminar is geared towards beginner and intermediate coaching up to an early international level. The coaches' seminar will be run 24th - 25th April 2014 in English.

In the same time, there will be a tournament judges' seminar aimed at developing people as judges. The seminar will cover the rules and the judge's role over the 3 events (slalom, trick and jump) with the aim to run and judge competitions up to International Level.

Additionally, there will be an opportunity for an Asian, Senior and National Judge Qualification exam on Saturday 26th.April 2014 with practical observations on Sat 26th Apr and Sun 27th Apr 2014 during the Nautique Ski & Wake Championships.
