It takes at present about 3 hours to travel from the Incheon International Airport to Chuncheon. However, it will take about 2 hours 10 minutes when a new express highway from Seoul to Chuncheon is completed and opened before the World Championships.

Weatherwise, Chuncheon averages 28-30 degrees Centigrade in air temperature with a rainfall of under 25-55mm and low wind velocity of 1 meter up and down during the dates of the World Championships.

5. Rules

The event will use the official 2008/09 IWSF World Wakeboard Rules.

6. Homologation

The Chief Judge will supervise and homologate the installation of the official competition Wakeboard course and obstacle (flat bar constructed by the Korea Water Ski Association).

7. Speaker(Commentator)

The organizer will provide a good Korean/English speaker.

8. Entry Requirements

All team members and riders to enter into the World Championships must follow the Rule 9 and 10 of Official IWSF World Wakeboard Rules.

A rider may compete in 2009 Chuncheon IWSF Wakeboard World Championships held in Lake Uiam, Chuncheon City on from August 24th to 29th as either a team representative or individual. All member Federations have to submit their "Intent to Enter" to the organizer, Korea Water Ski Association no more than June 24th, 2009.

8-1. Team entry

A team will comprise of a maximum of 8 riders, with a maximum of 2 riders in the same category. Refer to Rule 9 for details.

8-2. Individual entry

Riders who are not part of a team may compete as individuals. An individual rider's entry must be submitted through his respective Federation. Refer to Rule 9 for more details.

9. Entry fee

Entry fee for athletes will be USD170.00 per athlete. This includes lunch during the competition and a fee to attend the Opening Ceremony (dinner included) and Final Night Party (dinner included) on Saturday.

The entry fee must be paid at Registration in cash at either one of the two Official Hotels: (1) Hotel Ladena Condominium, and (2) Hotel Bears Chuncheon. Currency will be US Dollars.

10. Tentative Wakeboard World Championships' Schedule

13. Transport & Tourism

We recommend that all teams and athletes schedule their travel itineraries so that they arrive at the Incheon International Airport that is located one and half hours from Seoul. All athletes and their families with all IWSF and each National Federation' Officials including IWSF Judges and all IWSF related persons who attend at the 2009 Wakeboard World Championships in Chuncheon are direct-transported by the Organizer in the front of the Incheon Airport and before each Official Hotel on the basis of each arrival and departure times for all visitors.

All participants and officials must send their travel itineraries to the Organizer (kwsa1sts@ymail.com) no later than June 24th, 2009, so the Organizer can make transport arrangements.

15. Various Ceremonies & Farewell Party

The organizer will organize and host various ceremonies for the Championships.

16. Anti-doping

The organizer will prepare an anti-doping room and there will be random testing of athletes by anti-doping officers sent by the Korean Anti-Doping Association (KADA).

17. Liability

The Organizing Committee and IWSF will not be liable for any loss or damage to equipment or personal property, and injuries to athletes, officials, judges, official volunteers, and other persons attending official or unofficial programmes during the event.

Athletes are required to purchase and show proof of personal accident insurance prior to entry. The insurance policy must provide coverage internationally. The organizer will not be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any athlete from his participation in this event. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and / or hospitalization shall be borne by the athlete. Costs of medical treatment and hospitalization in Korea are high. Adequate personal medical insurance coverage is necessary. Certificate of medical insurance coverage / full payment is required before medical treatment / hospitalization takes place.

18. Pre-Competition Practice

Any team or rider can utilize the official Wakeboard World Championships site from August 21st to August 23rd, and August 25th. The practice fee is USD110.00 per an hour per a team and USD20.00 for an additional 20 minutes. For additional training, there are other wakeboard practice sites around a competition site, with practice fees ranging between KD 25,000 to KD 35,000 per a set.
