14.01: General

The contestant shall follow

The boat shall follow a straight path as close as possible to the centreline of the course. **This path shall be maintained from the entrance pre-gates and continue for as long as the skier is in the course.**

The skier may elect to waive

15.19: Trick Descriptions and Values

a) Except in the case of attempted side slide turns, a trick is any activity which occurs between two hesitations. ~~In the case of an attempted side slide, the hesitation in the 90-degree position is to be ignored in applying this rule.~~ Credit maybe.....

b) A wake turn not executed

To receive credit for the wake flip,

~~There will be two allowed styles of Front Flip referred to as an inside the line front flip and an outside the line front flip. An outside the line flip means that when the skier is going from right to left as seen from the boat, the skier's left hand (or both hands) must remain on the handle during the trick and at the landing. An inside the line flip going from right to left means that the skier releases the handle from the left hand and lands holding the handle with the right hand. After January 1, 2017, only outside the line front flips will be credited.~~

A front wake flip shall be defined as a forward somersault done in the air off the wake in which the tail of the ski passes up and over the head as the head goes down and forward. The rotation must be in the direction of travel and outside of the rope. Both feet must be above the head and in approximately the same vertical plane at some point during the execution of the trick. This rule applies to Front Flips and its derivatives. (ex: FFLF, FFLB, FFLBB, etc.)

For wake flips with body rotation

c) To be scored, a reverse trick must

The reverse WFLIPF (I or O) is defined as a WFLIPF (I or O) travelling in the opposite direction (right to left vs. left to right) from the original WFLIPF (I or O), immediately following it. A WFLIPFI is considered a reverse of either the WFLIPFI or the WFLIPFO if done in the opposite direction immediately after as described above and similarly for the WFLIPFO with the WFLIPFI or the WFLIPFO.

d) Stepover line tricks

e) ~~All side slides include a 90° turn from skiing position and a return to the skiing position in the original direction. Whether the side slide is hand-held or toehold, the ski must slide for at least 2m.~~

All side slide includes a 90-degree turn from skiing position and a return to skiing position in the original direction. In order for a Side Slide to be a creditable trick, the skier must hesitate before commencing the trick, turn 90 degrees to either side, stop, return to the starting position, and stop. To perform the reverse, the skier must turn 90 degrees in the opposite direction, stop, return to the starting position, and hesitate again

4.02 Skier Eligibility

Skiers eligible for this competition are Men and Women in the age categories listed below.

All ages refer to the age of the skier on the 31st December of the previous year.

- a) 35 to 44
- b) 45 to 54
- c) 55 years or more
- d) 65 years or more **(not counted in team scoring)**

There shall be no combination of divisions regardless of the number of contestants. Championship medals will be awarded in each division to the top three places (or the number of contestants if that is less than three) regardless of the number of contestants in the event. **~~A skier who qualifies for the 65+ division may ski in the 55+ division for team purposes. That skier must qualify for the 55+ division and must only ski in the 55+ division events.~~**
