SITE

The competition area is approximately 3500 feet in length. The beach and ending stage are in the middle of the course. Water conditions are continuously calm to light ripple due to the protection from trees on both sides of the river. Widths vary from 350 to 500 feet and the average depth is 12 feet.

ARRIVAL

Janesville is located northwest of Chicago, Illinois

By plane from O'Hare International Airport in Chicago, Illinois 90 miles via Interstate 90/39

By plane from Mitchell Field in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 75 miles south via Interstate 43 to Beloit, Wisconsin and then north on Interstate 90/39 Janesville, Wisconsin

By plane from Dane County Regional Airport in Madison, Wisconsin 40 miles south via Highway 30 west to Interstate 90/39 south to Janesville, Wisconsin

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee will be \$ 100.00US per team member. The entry fee will include 1 lunch ticket on site and 1 final banquet ticket. Entry fee shall be paid by deadline date of June 9, 2012

PAYMENTS

Visa and MasterCard credit cards accepted.

At the site payment shall be in U.S.Dollars only or credit card.

FOOD AND DRINK

Food and refreshment will be available during the tournament at the site.

ACCOMMODATIONS FOR TEAMS

Hotel rooms have been blocked off and are within 30 miles of the tournament site. They have various rates so please let us know as soon as possible how many rooms your team will need also what your budget is for rooms and we will make every effort to accommodate your needs.

TRANSPORTATION

The sponsor will provide the team transportation from the airport to the hotel then from the hotel to the tournament site and back to hotel. Transportation will be provided from hotel to all social functions and back to hotel. Upon departure, transportation will be provided from hotel to the airport.

ACCOMMODATIONS FOR OFFICIALS AND DIGNITARIES

Rooms have been reserved for officials and dignitaries, please confirm your intent to attend, your date of arrival and your transportation needs as soon as you are confirmed to officiate or attend this tournament. Please inform us of the airport you plan to fly into as soon as you are confirmed.

TOURNAMENT EQUIPMENT TO BE SUPPLIED BY SPONSOR

- Starting dock is 20 feet by 40 feet and covered in astro-turf carpeting.
- 2 auxilliary docks , 1 to the south and 1 to the north of main starting dock.
- 1 regulation jump 14 feet wide by 24 feet long and watered.
- The landing beach is 320 feet long and is sand.
- The payoff stage is 10 feet wide and 150 feet long covered in ground rubber for skier safety.
- A premium sound system will be provided.
- 2 inboard style towboats and 1 twin outboard style towboat plus 1 pickup boat will be provided.
- Full staging area will be provided for the team performing on the water.
- Full pre-staging area will be provided to each competing team.

SUPPLIMENTAL EQUIPMENT TO BE SUPPLIED

- Utility skis ie; ballet, conventional doubles, pyramids.
- Safety vests ie; flo-mos, jump vests.
- Doubles harnesses.
- Ropes for all acts.
- Some specialty skis such as swivel or step off skis.
- Safety releases for boats.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

As of our knowledge, visas are required for competitors from other countries. Please check with your embassy or consulate to verify requirements.

PRACTICE TRAINING

Practice at the tournament site will be available upon request. All needs of your team shall be made known to sponsors ie; number of towboats needed, safety personnel and concessions.

Cost of training sessions will be \$ 100.00 US per hour. Training costs to be paid prior to training session.

OFFICIAL TOWBOATS

At this time the official towboats have not been named. Two (2) quality inboard style boats and one (1) quality twin outboard style boat will be provided by the sponsor. All boats will be equipped with safety releases.

EMERGENCY PERSONNEL

The sponsor will provide emergency personnel certified in water rescue and transport during practice and competition.
