THIS HEIGHT WILL BE THE MIN.
HEIGHT THAT YOUR RAMP CAN BE SET AT.

WE USE 1 1/2 TON HYDRAULIC
JACKS WITH ABOUT 18" TRAVEL.
THIS IS MORE THAN ADEQUATE.
THE JACK STEM IS ABOUT 1"¢
AND SHOULD INSERT INTO A
SHORT SLEEVE ON THE JACKING
BEAM. A 1/4"¢ BOLT IS GOOD
SECURITY TO KEEP IT IN PLACE.
